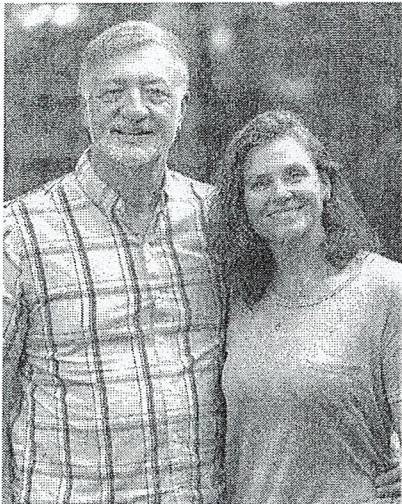


Missions Update Of The Week

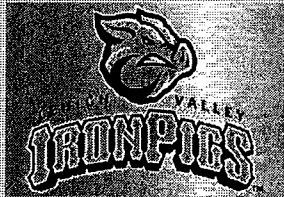

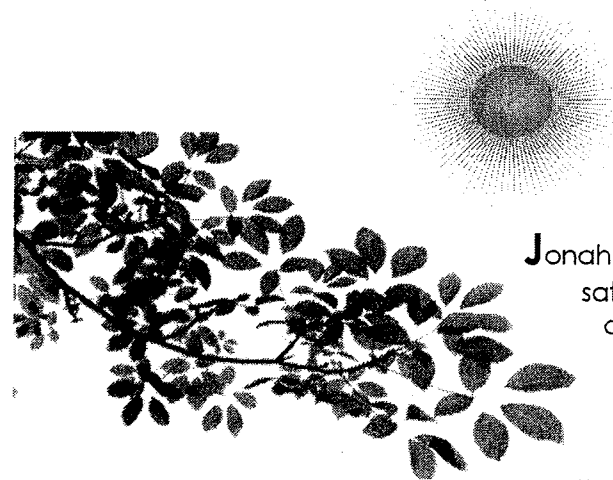
