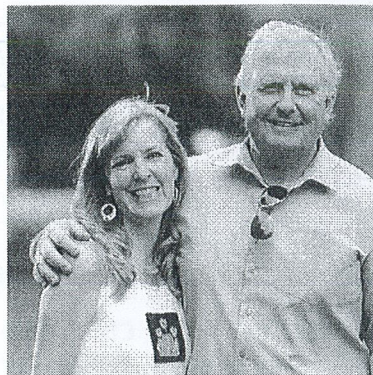

Dear Prayer Partners,

Bolivia has been experiencing a dry spell--all of Bolivia is very dry, including the jungles and lowlands. Every year, the Bolivians burn off their lands in order to plant their crops. For example, in the jungle, the families have plots of land where they grow their bananas, yucca and such. So, they burn the land and then plant. That works OK when the land is damp from the rains and when the rains arrive, but not when there is no rain and the ground is extremely dry. There is also a lot of wind in the country right now.

People have continued to burn their chacos (gardens); the winds have advanced the fires and they have gotten out of control. Much land has burned and thousands of animals have died.

Thank you for praying this past week. Bolivia still needs prayer for rain in other areas where many fires continue to burn. It has been very sad to see the cost to human and animal (domestic and wild) life.

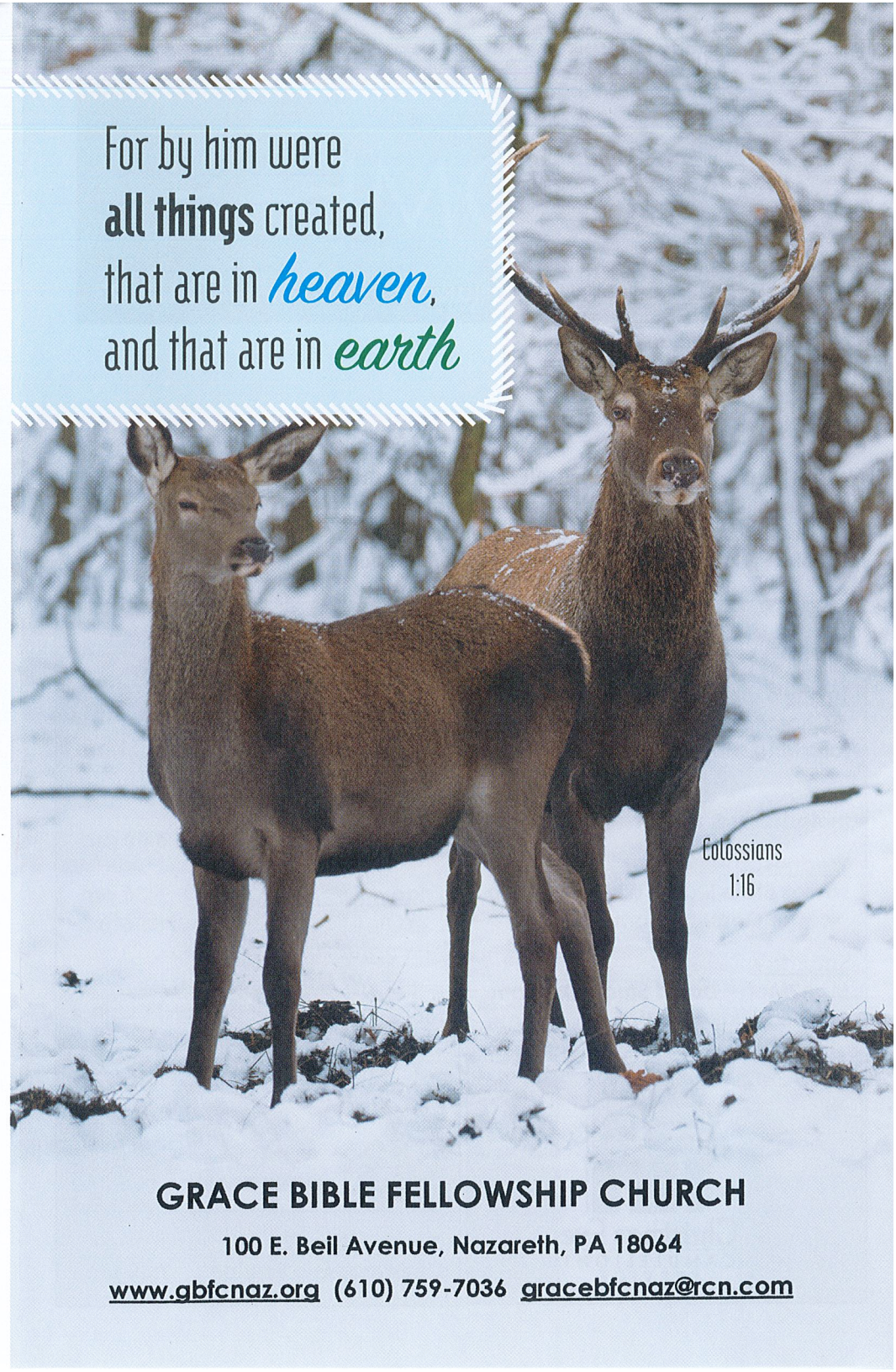
Tony still has not been able to fly and is backed up on flights due to the smoke from the fires. We had smoke come into our city yesterday from all of these fires. It just hung over the city. It rained a little bit last night in Cochabamba for which we were thankful, and it cleared the air a little bit, but the smoke still hangs over the city. This is nothing compared to places in the jungle and lowlands.
